

Call for Papers:

Empirical Management Conference 6th Edition

We will be running a two-day conference on empirical management, focused on recent empirical research on measuring and exploring management and organizational practices. We are seeking applied and empirical research papers in both the private and social sectors. This format follows Empirical Management Conferences at Harvard in 2014, at Stanford in 2015, at MIT in 2016, at the World Bank in 2017, and at the Harvard Business School in 2018.

The conference takes place at the World Bank Headquarters in Washington, D.C., on December 12-13, 2019.

Submissions are due by September 15, 2019 at 11:59 p.m. EST. Accepted papers will be notified by September 27, 2019.
